

Student-Athlete Academic Support Services

The Learning Assistance Program & Educational Impacting Disability Process

- Upon entry to VT, LAP examines student-athlete data and administers the Nelson-Denny exam to identify those who will most benefit from LAP services. Student-athletes also complete the LAP Questionnaire.
- If determined to be beneficial, students are enrolled in the appropriate level of LAP support.

- LAP staff or SAASS Counselor believes further testing may be needed for a student-athlete
- LAP staff meets with student one-on-one to discuss concerns and to offer the opportunity for testing

Student-athlete discloses existing documentation of a disability. LAP refers to SSD

Student declines testing

Student consents to testing

LAP Coordinator emails student outlining the steps in the testing process

Student meets with the Sport Psychologist from C.A.M.P.

Student declines further testing

Student consents to continuing with the testing process

Documentation uploaded and submitted to SSD via the secure online AIM Portal

- SSD establishes accommodations:
- SSD reaches out to student and schedules an onboarding meeting
 - Student meets with SSD and discusses requested accommodations
 - SSD approves or denies some or all requested accommodations
 - SSD inputs accommodations into AIM portal for student

Student completes testing with an independent agent

Testing results are returned to the LAP Coordinator and shared with Sport Psychologist and student

If student is on an LAP caseload, Learning Specialist meets with student to discuss implementation of accommodations in LAP, SAASS, and coaching activities, if appropriate

LAP may work with student to help set up accommodations with professors & classes
