## Student-Athlete Checklist

Accepting your offer generally includes the following steps. International and transfer students may involve a few different, or additional steps.

### YOU'VE APPLIED, BEEN OFFERED... NOW WHAT?

#### ACCEPT YOUR OFFER OF ADMISSION:

To accept your offer, log into your Applicant Portal, view your offer and fill out the Response to Offer of Admission form. You must complete the Community Standards questions. Once your deposit is processed- your acceptance will be reflected in your portal. The deadline to accept is May 1, 2023.

#### REMEMBER YOUR MAJOR AND STUDENT ID:

You will need these items when creating your Virginia Tech username, as well as throughout the process of becoming a student at Virginia Tech.

#### CREATE YOUR VT USERNAME:

Once your payment is processed and you have officially accepted your offer, you will receive an email with instructions on how to create your VT username (PID) and email address. Your email address will be your VT username followed by @vt.edu and can be accessed through Gmail by entering the full email address.

\*If you receive a "not found" error message, please allow more time. Please note that this can take 48-72 hours after your payment is received.

#### Go to: https://onboard.it.vt.edu/

- Enter your VT Student ID number: (nine-digit number 906\*\*\*\*\*)
- Enter your first and last names exactly as they appear in your portal and on your offer letter.
- Enter your date of birth (MM-DD-YYYY).
- Choose the exact major on your offer letter, without extra words or college designations.

#### **ON-CAMPUS HOUSING**

All first-year student-athletes reside on-campus in the newest dorm in The Creativity and Innovation District, known as CID.

#### StarRez Portal-

#### THINGS TO STILL BE WORKING ON:

#### DON'T GET CAUGHT UP IN THE "SENIOR SLUMP"

Stay focused on your school work. Virginia Tech expects students to maintain consistent grades, academic performance and completion of the University's minimum requirements once they've been offered admission.

OFFERS MAY BE WITHDRAWN UNDER ANY OF THE FOLLOWING CIRCUMSTANCES:

- If your final grades are significantly lower than your previous academic performance in your final year or semester.
- If your final transcript(s) reveals that you have failed to complete the University's minimum requirements for admission.
- If your self-reported academic record (SRAR) and your final official transcript have a major discrepancy.
- If your post-admission criminal record inquiry is not cleared.

Please note: if your semester grades fall below a 2.0, your offer of admission may be rescinded.

#### CHECK YOUR EMAIL

Virginia Tech will begin to send emails to your @vt.edu address once you create it, so it is very important to check this account regularly.

Check your VT email for important information such as Housing information, Orientation information and class registration.

#### FINAL GRADES AND OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT(S)

Send all official transcript(s) to the Athletic Department-Attention: Alison Whittaker- ahedrick@vt.edu \*Please DO NOT send them to the Admissions office\*

- Submit your final high school grades in your Self-Reported Academic Record by June 30, 2023.
- Submit official SAT/ACT scores by July 14, 2023 if you chose to have scores reviewed with your application.

#### OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS REQUIRED:

- First-Year Students- Final High school transcript(s) with date of graduation and dual enrollment transcript(s) (if applicable).
- Transfers- Final transcript(s) from ALL institutions attended and high school transcript with date of graduation.
  - Summer 1 enrollees- due by May 19, 2023
  - Summer 2 enrollees- due by June 16, 2023.
  - Fall enrollees- due by July 14, 2023.
