

SAASS: Additional Academic Support



Learning Assistance Program (LAP)

- Provides one-on-one support to students with education impacting disabilities or students who may be at-risk;
- Offers instruction in learning strategies, note taking, study skills, exam preparation, and time management;
- Assists students who would like to get accommodations while at Virginia Tech.

Tutoring Program

- Approximately 80 tutors on staff;
- Provides one-on-one and group tutoring in a variety of subjects;
- Offers recurring and one time appointments;
- Tutoring is available during all semesters.

Mentoring Program

- Offers one-on-one academic guidance to student-athletes as they learn how to navigate the academic demands of Virginia Tech;
- Fosters independent learning through various skill-building activities, such as time management, organization, and goal setting.

Services for Students with Disabilities (SSD)

- In order for students with disabilities to receive accommodations while they are students at VT they must do one of two things:
 1. Provide a psychoeducational evaluation, IEP or 504 plan from K-12 OR
 2. Be evaluated/re-evaluated by a local psychiatrist at the expense of VT athletics;
 - SAASS Learning Specialists will work directly with the student as they go through the testing process, if this is necessary.
